

March brings much anticipated excitement with our 8th annual Ocean City Film Festival screening in locations around the resort March 7-10. This year's festival will feature a diverse selection of 100 independent films, both short and feature length, ranging in genres that include romance, comedy, narrative, and even horror.

Film festivals are a great way to experience a variety of films in a short period of time. What makes them truly special is that



often the filmmakers are on hand to talk about their work and interact with the audience in question and answers sessions that follow the screenings.

The other truly fun part of the festival is the daily parties, receptions, and happy hours that are included in the tickets. They provide time to network and meet other film
